WHAT IS THE GOLDEN GRILLE CHALLENGE?

Every Father's Day weekend, local chefs gather at the Hillsboro's Lincoln Plaza to prove their prowess on the backyard grill. Armed with Webers, tongs and secret ingredients, competitors court judges and the public with tempting tastes of their very own freshly prepared recipes.

CHALLENGE GUIDELINES

1. Entrants must obtain a food permit in advance or on site the morning of the event from the Montgomery County Health Department. Requirements of the permit are:

- Entrants must have a bucket of sanitized water on hand at all times.
- Samples must be protected from overhead intrusions (i.e. sneeze guard, umbrella, or any other creative way you can come up with) and must be served from a small table separate from the entrant's cooking area (tables provided by entrants).
- Common dishwashing/sanitizing/hand washing facilities will be available in The Escape.

2. Entrants may set up their grills/equipment as early as necessary Saturday morning, June 19, in order to have samples ready by 11:00 am.

- Limit of 2 entrees per entrant.

3. Samples are to be provided from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm. Sample cups, toothpicks plates and napkins will be provided by The Journal-News, event sponsor. The 2000 & Beyond Committee will sell tickets for 50¢ per sample. Ticket sale proceeds will be split 50/50 between the entrants/Hillsboro 2000. Entrants will turn in their collected tickets for the Tasters' Choice prize.

4. Judging for the Golden Grille Trophy will begin at 11:00am. A maximum of two (2) entrees will be judged. Each entrée will be judged separately. Entries will be judged according to the following scorecard.
